

Frequently Asked Commercial Submittal Questions

- 1. Is the plan review online or paper submittal? Paper
- If online, please confirm the link to submit: N/A
- If paper, how many paper sets? Commercial Projects require 3 complete full sized signed & sealed engineer prints.
- Can we mail plans in or do they need to be dropped off in-person? Via Mail/ Courier or in person.
- What is mailing/drop off address?: 326 W. Marion Ave, Punta Gorda, 33950
- What type of sign and seal is needed (digital, wet, etc.)? Either
- 2. Are fees due upfront? NO, fees will be assessed once plans have been approved during the review process.
- If so, are they payable by CC online, check, etc.? Check/ Money order
- What is the fee due upfront? Fees are due at time of permit issuance.
- 3. Is a PDF of the plans required? No
- If so, are all pages needed in 1 PDF? N/A
- or is each page to be its own PDF? N/A
- does the PDF need to be signed and sealed (digital s&s, 3rd party verified, etc.)? N/A
- is there specific naming for any PDF documents? N/A
- any other requirements for the PDF plans (approval stamp area, etc.)? N/A
- 4. What forms are required upfront? Permit Application, Qualified Sub form and 3 sets engineered plans.
- Any other forms or sub contractor applications? Yes
- Will our plans be reviewed for Mechanical and Electrical if our set includes these trades? Yes
- 5. Do any forms require anyone other than the applicant to sign? NO, Solely the License Holder/ Qualifier should wet sign or digitally signed
 - If so, who (Landlord, tenant, GC, etc.)? N/A
 - Do those signatures need to be wet or just a scanned copy? Either
- 6. Do you need any landlord or owner signatures/approvals? No
- If so, what type (signature on a form, approved plans, letter, etc.)? N/A



- 7. Are there any separate depts that I will need to route plans to myself? (STATE, etc.) No, they will get routed to the proper departments once we have received the permit packet.

- Do we submit to them simultaneously or do we need their approval first? N/A
- 8. Does fire need to review plans <u>separately</u> for egress, etc **or** will they be <u>routed by your office</u>? They will reviewed separately, but can be submitted to the Building department for routing.
- 9. If we are modifying a few sprinkler heads, is that something that can be <u>submitted by the fire contractor deferred</u> **or** will it hold up the bldg permit submittal/ issuance process?

The intent of sprinkler work needs to be shown on building plans.

- 10. What is your current review time? 10 15 Business Days, but please understand that Commercial Projects must be submitted to DRC (Development Review Committee) which is a process that can take months. The plans may be submitted simultaneously, but cannot be issued until the DRC is approved, which is a much longer process.
- 11. If there are comments we need to address, what is the resubmittal review time once they are resubmitted/uploaded back in your system? Resubmittals and Revisions are an additional 10-15 days. We have Resubmittal and Revision forms located on the City's website under Building Forms
- 12. Do you offer an expedited review? No
- If so, what is the additional cost? N/A

- What is the shortened review time? N/A
- Is there anything additional needing to be submitted (plans, forms, etc.)? N/A
- 13. Do you need the contractor info <u>upfront</u> or can we <u>submit it with TBD</u> to get the review completed and then submit it prior to issuance? It may be submitted prior to issuance.



- If able to submit prior to issuance, are there any forms you need them to complete/ sign? The Permit application and qualifier sheet must be signed by Trade specific license holders and Qualifier.
- If so, please attach them or list the link to them.
- a. If needing their info upfront at time of submittal, what do you need from them (signed forms, just contact info, do they need to be registered/ licensed with your office upfront, etc.)? The Contractor/ Qualifier must be registered to do work within the City of Punta Gorda before application processing and permit issuance.
- 14. Do you require an asbestos report if doing any interior demo (removal of flooring, drywall, etc.)? STATE ASBESTOS NOTIFICATION REQUIRED For all Building permits (demolitions and renovations): Federal and State laws requires the owner and operator to submit a notice to the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) Form 62-257.900(1) prior to the removal of asbestos products and/or the demolition of a structure. For more information contact DEP at (239) 332-6975.
- If so, do you need the report upfront or just prior to issuance? See response for Question 14
- 15. Do you require a separate air quality approval? No
- If so, from which agency? N/A
- Do you require it prior to your approval? N/A
- 16. Do you need any energy, mechanical, structural calcs? Yes, they should be submitted with the plans.
- If so, do you need them in PDF (s&s), or hard copy? Hard Copy
- 17. Do you review for mechanical and electrical in-house or do we need to route those to any other departments/municipalities for review?

In House

- If so, which municipality? If the address is within City limits, then the permit must be pulled in the City of Punta Gorda.
- 18. For the shelving display fixtures they are looking to install that are **8-9'** tall, do you require <u>separate permits</u> for those, **or** will they be <u>covered under this bldg permit if shown on our plans? **Shelving, no; Storage racks, yes.**</u>
- If needing a separate permit, what is required (plans, forms, fees, review time, etc.)? N/A
- 19. Are you in a seismic area where you would require seismic calcs for these shelving fixtures? N/A
- If so, do you need them in PDF or hard copy? N/A



- 20. Do you offer a demo permit for them to start on demo before the bldg permit review is complete? If the structure is being demolished and totally razed to the ground, we do have a Demo permit application. If the interior is being remodeled, we do have a building permit for that.
- If so, what do we need to apply (# of plans, forms, GC info, fees, review time, asbestos report, etc.)? Commercial requires 3 sets of plans.
- 21. When do subcontractors pull their permits? No, the subs must be attached to the permit prior to issuance.
- Is it online or an OTC (over-the-counter) process? No, walked in with the commercial plans.
- How long does it typically take? 10-15 Business days
- 22. When is the NOC due (prior to issuance **or** inspection)? **Prior to 1st inspections.**

Who signs for owner (tenant or property owner)? License Holder / Qualifier

Does the person signing need to be listed on sunbiz.org? Yes

Does the NOC need to be certified or just recorded? Certified and Recorded
